


GO! Swirling Snail's Trail Quilt


Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
White	GO! Big Snail's Trail-12" Finished (55460)	Cut 7—13½" x width of fabric strips (WOF). Fanfold into 11¼" widths. Cut 40—A, Cut 40—B, Cut 40—C, Cut 40—D and Cut 40—E.	3 yards
Light Teal	GO! Big Snail's Trail-12" Finished (55460)	Cut 2—13½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 11¼" widths. Cut 10—A, Cut 10—B, Cut 10—C, Cut 10—D, Cut 10—E.	1 yard
Medium Teal	GO! Big Snail's Trail-12" Finished (55460)	Cut 2—13½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 11¼" widths. Cut 10—A, Cut 10—B, Cut 10—C, Cut 10—D, Cut 10—E.	1 yard

Snail's Trail Shapes

- A—2"W x 2"H square
- B—3½" quarter square triangle
- C—3½" half square triangle
- D—6½" quarter square triangle
- E—6½" half square triangle






Additional Fabrics Needed

- Binding—2/3 yard
- Backing—4 yards
- Batting—58" x 70"




Sewing Directions

1. Lay out two white A squares and two light teal A squares as shown.
2. Pin and sew blocks into rows, pressing seams towards the light teal.
3. Pin and sew rows together to make the center 4-patch. Block should measure 3½"W x 3½"H.
4. Turn center square counter clockwise one turn and lay out two white B triangles and two light teal B triangles as shown.
5. Pin and sew triangles onto center block, pressing towards the B triangles. Block should measure 4¾"W x 4¾"H.
6. Turn square counter clockwise one turn and lay out two white C triangles and two light teal C triangles as shown.
7. Pin and sew triangles onto center block, pressing towards the C triangles. Block should measure 6½"W x 6½" H.
8. Turn square counter clockwise one turn and lay out two white D triangles and two light teal D triangles as shown.
9. Pin and sew triangles onto center block, pressing towards the D triangles. Block should measure 9"W x 9"H.
10. Turn square counter clockwise one turn and lay out two white E triangles and two light teal E triangles as shown.
11. Pin and sew triangles onto center block, pressing towards the E triangles. Block should measure 12½"W x 12½"H.
12. Repeat steps 1 through 11 to make a total of five light teal blocks, five medium teal blocks, five medium dark teal blocks and five dark teal blocks.



13. Lay out blocks as shown.
14. Pin and sew blocks into rows. Pressing seams in opposite directions.
15. Pin and sew rows together to make the quilt top.



Quilting & Finishing

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was custom machine quilted.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
