

## GO! Wonky Heart Baby Quilt

Finished Size 42" x 58"  
Finished block size 6"

### GO!® Dies Used, Number of Shapes to Cut & Fabric Requirements

Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Assorted Prints	GO! Wonky Heart-6" Finished (55471)	Cut 35—10" x 10" squares or use 10" precut squares. Place up to 6 layers on die and cut 35 wonky heart parts. Leave all wonky heart parts in the correct orientation when removing from the die board.	35—10" x 10" squares or 35—10" precut squares
Yellow	GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 7—1½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips using the GO! Strip Cutter-1½". Sub cut into 42—1½" x 6½" rectangles.	1¼ yards
Yellow	GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 8—1½" x 50" rectangles for sashing.	Yardage included above

Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Green	GO! Strip Cutter-1" (½" Finished) (55052)	Cut 6—1" x WOF strips for inner border.	1/3 yard
Pink	GO! Strip Cutter-4" (3½" Finished) (55085)	Cut 6—4" x WOF strips for outer border.	1½ yards

### Additional Dies Needed:


- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)

### Additional Fabrics Needed:


- Binding—2/3 yard – Cut 7—2½" x WOF strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)
- Batting—52" x 68"
- Backing—3 yards

### Sewing Directions:


1. Leaving all wonky heart parts in the correct orientation, take the top fabric layer of shapes "H", "I" and "J" and move to bottom of each stack to shuffle colors. Each heart should be one color and the background a different color as shown.





2. Sew piece A to piece H as shown.
3. Sew piece B to A/H as shown.
4. Sew A/B/H to piece G as shown.

5. Sew piece J to piece I as shown.



6. Sew piece C to J/I, then sew piece F to C/J/I as shown.

7. Sew piece D to piece E as shown.

8. Sew A/B/H/G to C/J/I/F as shown.

9. Sew piece A/B/H/G/C/I/J/F to piece D/E as shown.

10. Block should measure 6½" x 6½". Make a total of 35 wonky heart blocks.

11. Lay out 35 wonky heart blocks, 42—1½" x 6½" rectangles, 8—1½" x 50½" rectangles as shown.


12. Sew wonky hearts and 1½" x 6½" rectangles into rows, pressing seams towards the Fabric 2 rectangles.

13. Sew wonky heart rows and 1½" x 50" rectangles together to make quilt center, pressing seams towards the Fabric 2 rectangles.

14. Sew the six inner border strips into one long strip along the short end.

15. Measure down the center of the quilt lengthwise and cut two borders to this length. Sew borders to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press towards the inner border.

16. Measure through the center of the quilt widthwise and cut two borders to this length. Sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press towards the inner border.



17. Sew the six outer border strips into one long strip along the short end.
18. Measure down the center of the quilt lengthwise and cut two outer borders to this length. Sew borders to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press towards the outer border.
19. Measure through the center of the quilt widthwise and cut two borders to this length. Sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press towards the outer border.

### Quilting and Finishing:

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
