Dies Needed:

GO! Qube Mix & Match 8" Block (55776)

- GO! Square-2½" (2" Finished) (Shape 2)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square (Shape 5)

GO! Qube™ 8" Companion-Corners (55785) OR GO! Qube™ 8" Companion-Classics (55780)

- GO! Chisels-2" x 4" Finished (Shape 9)

Additional Dies Needed:

- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (3" Finished) (55032)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Medium Red Fabric	2½ yards
Dark Red Fabric	1/4 yard
Background Fabric	2 yards
Batting	50" x 68"
Backing	3 yards

GO! Qube 8" Cutting Directions:


Fabric Color	Shape & #	Number of Shapes to Cut
Dark Red: Bear's Paw		Cut 1—5½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip plus one 5½" x 5½" square. Fanfold into 5½" widths and place on die. Sub cut into 30 squares.
Medium Red: Bear's Claw		Cut 1—3¾" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 24 half square triangles (HSTs).
Medium Red: Bear's Claw		Cut 48 chisels with right side of fabric facing up. Cut 4—5" x WOF strips. Place up to six layers of fabric with right side of fabric facing up and advance the strip as each chisel is cut. Note: Do not fan-fold.
Medium Red: Bear's Claw		Cut 24 chisels with wrong side of fabric facing up. Cut 2—5" x WOF strips. Place up to six layers of fabric with wrong side of fabric facing up and advance the strip as each chisel is cut. Note: Do not fan-fold.
Background: Bear Claw Outer Corner		Cut 1—5½" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5½" widths and place on die. Sub cut into 24 squares.
Background: Chisel Corners		Cut 4—3¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 96 HSTs.

Additional Cutting Instructions:

- Medium Red Inner Border—Yardage included in fabric requirements table
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 5—2½" x WOF strips for inner medium red borders. Stitch together following instructions. Sub cut 2 strips into 2½" x 50½" and sub cut 2 strips into 2½" x 34½".
- Medium Red Binding—Yardage included in fabric requirements table
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 6—2½" x WOF strips for binding. Use standard methods for binding quilt.
- Background Fabric Vertical Sash—Yardage included in fabric requirements table
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 9—2½" x 14½" Rectangles.
 - Cut 1—14½" x WOF strips. Fanfold across 2½" strip die three times. Save remaining fabric to use for Inner Block Sash below.
- Background Fabric Inner Block Sash—Yardage included in fabric requirements table
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 24—2½" x 6½" Rectangles.
 - Cut 1—6½" x WOF strips. Fanfold 6½" strips across 2½" strip die. Cut the remaining rectangles from the leftover fabric from the Vertical Sash into 6½" x remaining WOF. Fanfold across 2½" strip die for remaining Inner Block Sash rectangles.
- Background Fabric Horizontal Sash—Yardage included in fabric requirements table
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 4—2½" x WOF strips. Sub cut to 34½" each.
- Background Fabric Outer Border—Yardage included in fabric requirements table
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (3" Finished) (55032) to cut 6—3½" x WOF strips. Stitch together as per instructions. Sub cut 2 strips into 3½" x 44½" and sub cut 2 strips into 3½" x 54½".

Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.



Bear's Paw Block (Make 6 Blocks)

1. Sew one background fabric 2" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) to one medium red "left" chisel (Shape 9) as shown. Press seams to dark fabric. Make 48 "left" chisel units.




2. Sew one background fabric 2" finished HST (Shape 5) to one medium red "right" chisel (Shape 9) as shown. Press seams to dark fabric. Make 24 "right" chisel units.




3. Sew one red and one background 2" finished HST (Shape 5) together. Press seams to dark fabric. Make 24 HST units.




4. Sew two "left" chisel units together. Press seams towards the long side of the chisel. Make 24 "Left" Chisel Corner Units.




5. Sew one HST unit to one background fabric 2 1/2" square (Shape 2). Press seam allowance toward the HST unit to make a Corner Unit. Make 24 Corner Units.




6. Sew one Corner Unit to a “left” chisel unit as shown. Press seam allowance towards the long side of the chisel. Make 24 Corner/”Left” Chisel Units.




7. Sew one “right” chisel unit to one dark red 2½" square (Shape 2). Press seam allowance toward the “right” chisel unit. Make 24 “Right” Chisel/Square Units.



8. Sew one Corner/”Left” Chisel Unit to one “Right” Chisel/Square unit to complete the corner. Nest seams so they are pressed in the opposite direction. Make 24 units for the entire quilt.




9. Complete block assembly by stitching corner units together with Inner Block Sashing and one red 2½" square (Shape 2).



Assemble Quilt Blocks and Sashing

1. Lay out blocks as shown with Vertical and Horizontal Sashing.
2. Pin and sew blocks into rows with vertical sash framing sides of block. Press seam allowance towards sashing.
3. Pin and sew rows together with horizontal sashing as shown below to complete the inner quilt top.
4. Press seam allowance towards sashing.



Add Borders


Inner Border

1. Stitch the 2½" width medium red inner border together with a bias seam or end to end according to your preference.
2. Cut the vertical and horizontal borders according to the cutting instructions on page 3.
3. Stitch the inner border to the long sides of the quilt first. Pin carefully, easing quilt top as needed to fit the border.
4. Stitch the inner border to the top and bottom of the quilt. Again, pin carefully, easing quilt top as needed to fit the border.
5. Press seam allowances to the inner border.



Outer Border

1. Stitch the 3½" background fabric outer border together with a bias seam or end to end according to your preference.
2. Cut the vertical and horizontal borders according to the cutting instructions on page 3.
3. Stitch the outer border to the long sides of the quilt first. Pin carefully, easing quilt top as needed to fit the border.
4. Stitch the outer border to the top and bottom of the quilt. Again, pin carefully, easing quilt top as needed to fit the border.
5. Press seam allowances toward the inner border.



Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
