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Blanket Stitch Rooster

Want to learn the specifics of blanket stitch appliqué? This "cupboard art" is the perfect project! Chris will take you step-by-step through the process of blanket stitch appliqué. You will learn How to utilize your machine and the Bernina feet to accomplish this stitch. Beginners welcome Supplies:

- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies

• Fabric: (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ × 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ Light background rectangles, and (9) $1\frac{1}{2}$ × 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles of

various scraps for the rooster

• Blending thread for piecing and appliqué (You will see the thread on the rooster)

- #37/#97 piecing foot
- #20/#20D appliqué foot
- Regular stitch plate
- A piece of steam-a-seam that is $10'' \times 12''$
- Fabric marker

And for finishing (Not addressed in class)

• A $11'' \times 13''$ rectangle of batting, or In R Form (as in the sample)

• Binding
