

Kimberbell's Cup of Cheer  
Machine Embroidery Class

- \*Kimberbell Cup of Cheer Pattern book with CD
- \*Kimberbell Cup of Cheer embellishment kit
- \*Kimberbell fabric bundle
- \*Usb with embroidery designs downloaded from the cd in your format
- \*Background quilting designs also downloaded on the usb (if using)
- \*Stabilizer – fusible backing, light mesh cut away, and wash away, plus KB project batting or battilizer
- \*Thread that coordinates with fabrics for quilting and applique  
(see attached thread chart for suggestions)
- \*Bottom line bobbin thread (or two full bobbins), plus a bobbin with a visable thread color such as black for the Snowman fringe block.
- \*Embroidery machine in good working order and knowledge of use
- \*Embroidery Module
- \*Embroidery hoops (5x7 & 6x10) or closest equivalent size
- \*Plastic templates for the above mentioned hoops

- Kimberbell or OESD paper tape
- curved embroidery scissors
- small sewing scissors
- marking pen/pencil
- 80/12 Sharps or Embroidery needles
- Pressing cloth

\*\*Please have the fabric cut for the following blocks:

- Pg. 34 – Mylar applique block – steam (3.5 x 5.5 piece of batting)
- Pg. 41 - Gift box 1 (7.5 x 7.5 batting)
- Pg. 47 - Blue house (5.5 x 9.5 batting)
- Pg. 32 – Snowman fringe block (7.5 x 9.5 batting)

We will work on the above mentioned blocks in the order listed. It would be helpful if you familiarize yourself with the instructions for each.

Please see the attached page for thread suggestions.
