

Dainty Daytripper Backpack Supply List

Supplies:

- Pattern: Dainty Daytripper by Mrs. H (MH-DAINTY)
- Fabric: As listed on pattern or as desired.
- Medium weight interfacing = woven fusible or Pellon SF-101 (Shape Flex)
- For store sample, I used:
 - For outer back and front pocket – fussy cut
 - ½ yd for outer front
 - ½ yd for lining
 - ¾ yd of orange stripe
 - ½ yd of orange grunge
 - 3/8 yd of floral linen for strap
 - Foam 18"x36" and SF-101 (lots)
- Hardware: As listed on pattern (I used all #5 zipper by the yard and 1" sliders and hardware)
- Addition: If using quilting cotton for side zipper ends, purchase ¼ yd of Decovil light. This is not necessary if using vinyl or cork, optional for linen or canvas. (Pieces can be cut ½" smaller on all sides for the piece "Top Zip Ends.") *** You could also use 2 layers of SF-101 instead of Decovil light.
- Pressing mat and small iron (optional)
- Walking foot or dual feed
- Zipper foot (required), edge stitch foot (opt), Teflon foot (opt but suggested if using vinyl)
- Glue: E-6000, Fabritac, superglue or similar.
- Fray-Check or seam sealant (optional)
- Small ruler – 12"
- Marking pen or pencil
- Basting or double stick tape (I like Nancy's Notions)
- Duct tape or Gorilla Tape (only need a small amount, so don't go buy a roll if you do not have any at home.)

Notes:

1. This is not a difficult pattern, but it has a lot of parts. Just stay organized and enjoy the process! You will learn some new techniques, but it might be more challenging as your first bag. Ask me if you have any questions!
2. This is NOT suitable for all cork or vinyl, and even linen or canvas should be used in combination with quilt cotton. Again, ask before class if you have any questions.
3. If you are comfortable with the materials and interfacings you want to use, you can cut out your pieces before class. We will be starting with the strap and the back of the backpack, but we might get further on day #1 if everyone has more pieces ready to go. Again... don't hesitate to reach out before class if you have questions! Are you noticing a theme? 😊
4. Pay attention to the dates of the classes – there is a week we skip. See you soon!
