

Make Your First Quilt Class

VERY IMPORTANT PRIOR TO THE CLASS: If you need help threading your machine, winding a bobbin, or selecting a 1/4" patchwork foot and/or a walking foot for your machine, please ask one of our staff members prior to your class. We want you to have fun learning the project! :) The instructor does not know all the makes and models and how to use all the machines. Knowledge of the machine is the student's responsibility prior to class.

SUPPLY LIST:

BOOK: Teach Me to Make My First Quilt by Pat Sloan

Sewing machine in good working order and knowledge of how to use your machine

- Bobbins
- Thread: 50 or 60 weight light grey, fog or cream color for sewing top pieces together; thread color to match or coordinate for quilting
- 1/4" piecing/patchwork foot
- Walking foot
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting Mat (recommend 18x24 or larger)
- Ruler (6" x 24" or 6 1/2" x 24 1/2") (we recommend Quilters Select or Creative Grids)
- Small scissors (for cutting threads)
- Seam Ripper
- Marking pencil (Sewline or mechanical with a fine point)
- Pins - straight pins
- Quilter's safety pins (optional)
- Machine needles (80/12 Sharps and 90/14 Quilting or 90/14 topstitch)
- Hand needles (optional)
- Optional: 12 1/2" square ruler

FABRIC: You will want to select light, medium and dark fabrics for the best results.

- Feature Fabric 1 1/4 yards
- Background Fabric 1/2 yard
- Contrasting Fabric 1/2 yard
- Sashing Fabric 1/2 yard
- Backing fabric 1 5/8 yard
- Crib size Batting or 28" x 56"

For the beginning class, we will be making a sampler quilt with three blocks from the book: Rail Fence, Saw Tooth Star, and Churn Dash. It can be a table runner or wall hanging.

Please bring your sewing machine in good working order and have knowledge of your sewing machine. Bring your sewing machine and supplies to all classes.
