You will need to prep for the Workshop.

- Order your pattern from the Ann Arbor Sewing Center.
- ✤ The Pocket Compass Wall Hanging pattern makes ONE Wall hanging.
- ◆ Additional papers may be purchased to make another Wall Hanging.
- Corrections are posted on the Quiltworx Website. If needed make necessary corrections. See Page 1 GENERAL INFORMATION.
- Read the instructions and become familiar with the common tools and terms.
- ◆ Verify you have (1) NP 751, (1) NP 752 and (1) NP 954 papers in your packet.
- **Complete page 6 Preparing the Foundation Papers and Templates: Place your papers in labeled plastic zip lock bags and bring to the Workshop.
- Complete the NORTH STAR FABRIC INFORMATION chart on page 6. You will glue a small swatch of fabric in the appropriate assigned color box.
- I find it is easier for students to pre-cut the Strips needed before coming to the first Workshop ... Please complete the STRIP CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS for each fabric: STOP and read that again ... I want you to cut the strips (ONLY) needed for each fabric... you do not need to subcut using the Template Layout Sheets... we will sub-cut in the First Workshop. Feel free to call me about this step.*

*It is important that you complete the fabric Strip cutting and come to the Workshop ready to sew. Sashing and borders will be discussed in the Workshop.

- Quiltworx Pocket Compass Wall Hanging Pattern
- Fabric requirements per Quiltworx Pocket Compass Wall Hanging

I am happy to help you with fabric selection. Please call me before the Workshop begins.

- Sewing machine
- 6" x 12" ruler and 6 X 24 ruler (or similar)
- Medium or Large size cutting mat (18" x 36" or 12 X 18)
- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm

(I like to have both, bring both if you own them)

- OLD blade for cutting paper, New rotary blades for cutting fabric,
- Add a Quarter Tool
- Jumbo Paperclips (1) box
 - Seam ripper
- Scissors
- UHU Glue Stick (any washable glue stick)
- Glue Pen (any brand ...Sewline, Avery, Fons and Porter)
- Repositionable (this is NOT a permanent glue) glue stick (I use SCOTCH brand)
- Flower pins (fine)
- Scotch Tape
- 1 or 2 Gallon Size Ziploc Bags need 3 bags
