

Supplies Needed for Hot Stuff Oven Mitt:

42-44" wide quilting fabric, linen or decorator weight fabric: Best with high-contrast, bright fabrics on a white or light background.

- 1 Fat Quarter (FQ) or ¹/₂ yard for featured exterior print
- 1 FQ or ½ yard for liner
- 1 Fat Eighth (FE) or 1 FQ or 1/8 yard for lower band and binding
- 1 FQ or ½ yard of white cotton or muslin for liner

Batting:

• 1/2 yard of cotton batting

Other Supplies:

- Hot Stuff Oven Mitt Pattern (this includes one silicone overlay to make one mitt. If you want to make two matching mitts, you will need a refill (available at Ann Arbor Sewing Center).
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- Fabric marking pen
- Fabric clips
- Walking foot recommended
- Sharp needle for machine
- Stiletto or chopstick
- Thread
- Sewing machine in good working order
- Freezer Paper, if you wish (see below)

NOTES:

You will be able to complete one mitt in class. If you want to make a pair, please be sure to purchase enough supplies for two, as you may not be able to purchase the same fabric when you are ready to make the second mitt.

Please come to class with the lining already quilted in any fashion you prefer (see "LINING" Nos. 1 & 2 in the pattern).

I used freezer paper to make the template for the mitt and used a Sharpie pen to trace it onto the white muslin. It won't show in the finished product.
