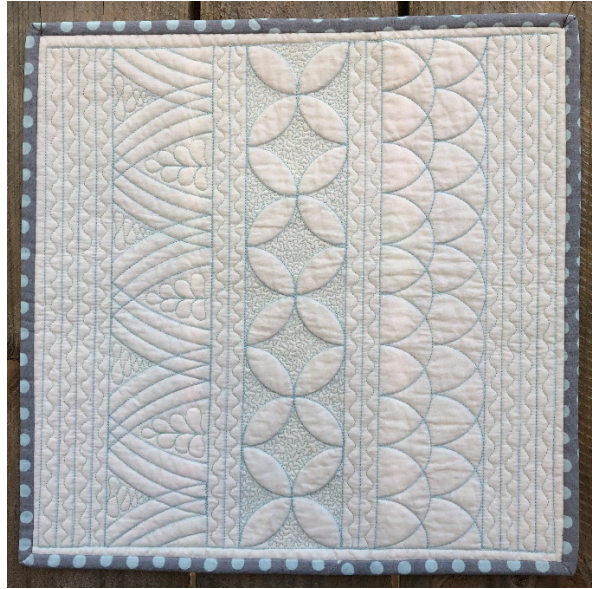


Ruler Work on the Home Machine- Basic Shapes
All levels (some free motion quilting experience helpful)



In this class, play with your ruler foot and rulers to achieve easy curves and straight lines. This approach will open the doors to many new options for free motion work on the home machine. Sue will start with basic concepts, then continue with cool and creative ideas! Traditional free motion quilting will be added after rulerwork is complete. Students will work on a small 18" x 18" project provided in a kit. Join in on the fun in this relaxed and informative workshop!

Kit fee: \$40.00 (includes Sue Nickels Straight Line Ruler, marked fabric for top, batting, backing and thread)

Supply list:

Sewing Machine (please bring sewing machine slide on tray table, foot pedal and power cord)

Ruler Foot (you must have the correct ruler foot for your machine- please make sure the ruler foot you have fits your machine before coming to class)

Open toe darning foot

Straight Stitch Throat Plate (if you have one, please bring)

80/12 Microtex Sharp Sewing Machine Needles

Scissors or snips for clipping thread

Quilting gloves or quilters fingertips- Sue uses fingers cut off of good quality kitchen dishwashing gloves
